1. Any new building and/or construction will require a building request (assessment permit). This includes mobile homes, modular homes, trailers, camps, RV's, existing buildings or structures, and all new constructions. You will need to contact a Building Code Officer of your choice, but Erb Building Inspection is Summit Township's primary code inspector. Erb Inspection can be reached at (570) 827-3474. There is a web site as well. Applications, information or appointments can be obtained by calling the Twp Secretary, Carol Putt-Ayers at (814) 320-3754 or 724-840-3690. Monthly meetings are held on the first Tuesday of each month at 6:00 P.M. at 43 S. Ayers Hill Road, Coudersport, PA 16915 for approval of permit.

2. Permits must be posted fifteen days prior to any construction on the property involved. The permit is good for three (3) months of the permit issue date.

3. Assessment permit fees are: \$0.00 - \$499.00 is \$1.00; \$500-\$1,000 is \$5.00. Each additional \$1,000 or part thereof beyond the first \$1,000 is \$1.00. An estimate of cost is to be established and payment must be received before permit can be issued. Check to be made payable to **Summit Township**.

4. A sewage permit is required before a building request can be issued where new construction is involved or where major changes to an existing system can be made.

5. Contact Roger Bickelman, Summit Twp Sewage Enforcement Officer at (814) 698-2457 for a new or repair application. Get fees from Terry. A repair must be completed within 60 days of the date the application was issued.
